COVID-19 SAFETY PROTOCOLS

TEI is pleased to welcome the in-house tax professional community back to in-person events! Our top priority remains the health and safety of our attendees, sponsors, speakers, and staff. By observing COVID-19 safety guidelines established by San Francisco and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, we believe that we, along with our partners at the San Francisco Marriott Marquis, can foster a safe, welcoming environment for our communities to share the experiences they rely on TEI to provide. Attendees who do not provide a proper form of vaccination verification or proof of a negative test cannot participate in the Tax Technology Seminar.
